### A&E at St Cross

I am campaigning for Accident & Emergency care at the Hospital of St Cross, something we lost in the 1990s. After running a constituency-wide survey on local healthcare, I secured a debate in Parliament and have called on the government to help bring A&E to Rugby.

### Improving Rugby Town Centre

I am fully behind the Conservative-led Borough Council's drive to regenerate the Town Centre. The High Street forms the backbone of our local economy, which is why I welcome the unparalleled investment which has been made in it nationally through the Towns Fund, Future High Streets Fund and the High Streets Task Force.

### Protecting the environment

Protecting the environment for future generations is a top priority for me and the government. The UK was the first major economy to commit in law to reaching net-zero by 2050 and our Net Zero Strategy outlines how we will secure 440,000 well-paid jobs and unlock £90 billion in investment by 2030.

The government is committed to levelling-up across the country to ensure equality of opportunity for all. I will work to ensure Rugby & Bulkington receives the funding we deserve in the years ahead to ensure our communities remain great places to live, work and raise a family.

Residents in Rugby & Bulkington deserve good access to GPs and the ability to easily book an appointment at their local surgery. The government has committed £1.5 billion to create an additional 50 million GP appointments by 2024 and is also supporting the training, retention and recruitment of GPs to help increase the number of appointments.


